

SPECIAL COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS

August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024

The Loup County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment, in special session, this 21<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2024 at 9:30 A.M. at the Loup County Courthouse in Taylor, Nebraska. Present were Commissioners Larson, Steckel, and Ruppel, County Clerk Copsey, Deputy County Clerk Moon, Deputy County Clerk Jones, County Treasurer Starr, Caleb Johnson, Sheriff Spanel, Trevor Kraus, Tootie Ruppel, Wayne Ruppert, Ashley Eley, Kyle Shepard, Marah Sandoz. Chairman Larson called the meeting to order. Receipt of advance notice and agenda for the August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024 meeting was affirmed by all members present. Chairman Larson referenced the Open Meeting Laws poster located in the meeting room and advised that handouts concerning said laws are available to the public.

Discussion of the Loup County 2024-2025 proposed annual budget. Caleb Johnson was present to discuss the proposed budget. Adjustments were made to the budget after examining expenditures from the 2023-2024 budget. Tax asking kept as close to the previous year as possible.

Steckel moved to adopt a resolution for authorization/reauthorization of petty cash funds. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ruppel. Roll call vote; yes; Larson, Steckel, and Ruppel. Nays; absent; not voting; none. Said resolution can be found in Commissioners Record No. 10 Page 468.

Ruppel moved to adopt a resolution to approve an additional one percent increase to the base amount for restricted funds authority; for a total increase of three and one-half percent in the restricted funds authority for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steckel. Roll call vote; yes; Larson, Steckel, and Ruppel. Nays; absent; not voting; none. Said resolution can be found in Commissioners Record No. 10 Page 469.

Steckel moved to adopt a resolution of the 2024-2025 allocation of real and personal property tax made to political subdivisions. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Larson. Roll call vote; yes; Larson, Steckel, and Ruppel. Nays; absent; not voting; none. Said resolution can be found in Commissioners Record No. 10 Page 470.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned at 2:16 p.m.
